Security

Our website uses SSL end to end encryption on all pages on our website creating an encrypted path for your data from your browser to our servers and from our servers to your browser. Gatekeeper technology prevents unauthorized access to secure areas of our website. We also use encrypted URLs to prevent URL manipulation. Our website uses industry standard best practices to prevent unauthorized access to data on our servers.

Our Website

You are able to visit our website (“Website”), www.donations4education.com, www.donate4edu.com or www.ClaimYourPage.com without revealing any personal information. Our Website automatically collects and monitors user traffic and may identify user data such as IP address, browser type, operating system type, data and time of the visit. This information is collected in order to ensure the Website displays content in the most appropriate manner as well as increase or decrease computing power on our server system.

Minors Online Privacy Protection

Our Website is intended to be used by parents, guardians, teachers and school staff of fundraiser participants over the age of 13. When creating a new account, you are agreeing that you are at least 13 years old. We will never ask for a minors contact information.

Collected Information

Most information collected is entered by fundraiser administrators or school staff. This information (“Fundraiser Information”) is composed of but not limited to school name, address, phone number, email addresses, fundraiser name, type, fundraising goals, dates, descriptions, student first name, student last name, grade, parents email addresses, teacher first name, teacher last name, teacher email addresses, donors name, donors email addresses, donors address, donors phone number.

How Fundraiser Information is used

Fundraising Information is used to display information of the Website in order to facilitate the fundraiser. Share pages are generated for the school, each class and each family. The Website allows fundraiser administrators to email parents and teachers using the email portal.

We may share Fundraising Information

We may share Fundraising Information or other collected information from visitors in order to:

- Facilitate fundraisers
- Resolve disputes
- when required by law
- conduct business

Accessing Accounts

Accounts are provided for each teacher and each student. Students that share parents or guardians are groups together within on family account for convenience of both parents and donors. A student code ("Student Code") is provided to each student on the student fundraiser handout. This code can be used to claim the account of each student and should be kept confidential. Codes should not be shared with anyone outside of the household. In order to make accounts more secure, you may lock your access codes after claiming your page.

Information Collected by Third Parties

In order to facilitate the fundraiser, we work with third parties such as credit card processors. We also use services by Amazon AWS Web Service and Google. Information may be collected and used differently for third parties may be applicable to other terms of use or privacy policies.

Cookies

Cookies are small blocks of data created by a web server while a user is browsing a website and placed on the user's computer or other device by the user's web browser. Cookies are placed on the device used to access a website, and more than one cookie may be placed on a user's device during a session. You can choose to reject cookies from our website, however, this may also hinder our ability to display your pages on the Website.
